First Aid Training:

A big thank you to St John Ambulance and Wayne for our training session on 2nd September in Llangennith Parish Hall, it was well attended with lots of people asking for another session. We plan to arrange a Public Access Defibrillator Awareness course, then an Outdoor First Aid course and will keep you updated.

Defibrillator pads

We mentioned in August that the defibrillators at Blas Gwyr in Llangennith, The Bunkhouse at Hardingsdown Farm and Kennexstone Camping and Touring Park had their pads replaced by the ambulance service once used. This is no longer the case and the community council will now be doing this so please let the clerk or a councillor know if you know that one has been used.

Llanmadoc Village Hall refurbishment:

Just a reminder that the Llanmadoc Village Hall Refurbishment Committee is carrying out a feasibility study regarding a refurbishment plan for the building and have contacted the community council asking whether they would be able to purchase a strip of land around the hall, which is owned by the community council. This would allow an outside space for socialising and also help manage the drainage required for the development.
